Drawn Games

In the event of any match being drawn after normal playing time, extra time will be played immediately.
2 x 15 minutes for Senior Men and Women 2 x 10 minutes for all other divisions

If, however, there is still no final result at the end of the extra time period, then penalty kicks in accordance with FIFA Rules will be taken to determine the winner.

Interchange

The Interchange rules as per those which appear in the Manager's Handbook will apply to all Junior Matches – including Under 17, 3rd Division, 4th Division, Women and Over 35 – (16 players maximum).

Match Footballs

The host club is responsible for providing two match balls for each game.

Team Sheets

Team Sheets must be filled in correctly, clearly and signed by all players using their correct signature – not nicknames.

Submission of Team Sheets We *must* have the team sheets (or faxed or emailed copies) in the Zone Office the Monday after the weekend of each week of the finals. The Zone Office must check player eligibility to finalise positions and ensure that the next week's draw can be done in a timely fashion.

Football QLD Marketing

All players (including Goal Keepers) are required to wear only FQ endorsed clothing.

Disciplinary

As per the SCF By-laws, two cautions incurred during the Finals Series automatically means that the player will be suspended for one (1) match. The suspension will be served in the next authorized match in which the said player is involved during the Final Series.

Gate Fees

Semi Finals and Preliminary Finals	- \$3 Adults	\$1.50 Pensioners
Grand Finals	- \$5 Adults	\$2.50 Pensioners

Gate Passes

Gate Passes will be provided to all teams taking part in the finals series. 19 passes to senior teams, 3 passes to junior teams. Host Clubs will be provided with copies of these passes for Semi-finals, Preliminary Finals & Grand Finals for comparison.

Pass Outs

Please utilize the collected admission passes as pass outs for those who may be traveling to other grounds on the same day/night. Whilst they are only valid for that day/night but they can be used at any of the finals venue on that day/night.

Referee Room

The Referee Room should have the name of the Ground Official displayed in a prominent place.
